

WELCOME TO NORWAY!

We offer you two days together with Guild members in and around Oslo. You must order the ticket from Stockholm to Oslo by yourself. We can order hotel rooms, but it is probably cheaper for you to order it together with the flight-ticket. Please inform us of what you choose to do regarding hotel accommodation!

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8TH, EVENING

Visit a Norwegian home. Dinner is served and you may taste reindeer, salmon and other typical Norwegian food. We hope the guests will bring with them something to drink. The rest is free.

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9TH, COST: NKR 400,-

After breakfast at your hotel, we will go by private cars to *Kvernmoen*. On the way we stop at the rock carvings (from around 100 BC) at Solberg.



Lunch at a campsite owned by the Guild (perhaps a little trip in a canoe at the lake?).



On the way home to Oslo, we make a stop at the fortress in Halden

If the weather is good, we stop at a typical summer house for coffee/ tea; otherwise we stop on the way home at a historic place for the same.

OR

Train to Hamar.



On your way you will see the indoor skating arena "The Viking Ship".

You will be met by local Guild members who will take you around the picturesque city of Hamar and show you the ruins of the old Hamar Cathedral and the historical museum.

Lunch will be served at the local Scout house.

Both tours end in Oslo, dinner at one's own expense (together, if you like, in a restaurant chosen by us).

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10TH, COST NKR 400,-

Breakfast at the hotel. Then we take a tour around Oslo and visit: Vigelandsparken.



Have a walk on the roof of the opera building and perhaps visit the town hall.



Take the little boat to Bygdøy and see the Viking ships and/or the Polar Ship Fram and/or the Folk Museum and/or the KonTiki raft



Dinner at one's own expense (together, if you like, in a restaurant chosen by us).

And still there is a lot more to see we can decide what to see on Monday evening!
