Welcome you 180 participants to the Nordic Baltic Sub region! The preparations are progressing; we need your attention to some issues.

About registration and payment

We understand that it was difficult for you to give day and time of arrival and departure very early. But as soon as you have that information and not yet given it to us, please use e-mail isgf2013@gmail.com or a letter to Europakonferens, c/o Scouterna, B.Johnsen, Slånbärgsgatan 11, SE-722 23 Västerås, Sweden.

From Arlanda you can go either by bus or by train to the *Cityterminalen*. The bus costs SEK 99, if you are a senior citizen SEK 79. The bus runs every 10 minute and takes 40 minutes to the Cityterminalen. The train takes 20 minutes and stops just outside the hotel, costs SEK 260, if you are a senior citizen SEK 130. About the programme

Many of you are arriving on the 4th of September. The sightseeing at 1 pm start at the Hotel Nordic Sea and you will walk to the Old Town of Stockholm. That tour takes about 1,5h. If you want to see more of Stockholm we recommend you to take the Hop on- hop off Open Top bus. It costs SEK 260. Or if you want to see Stockholm by boat you can go by Hop on-hop off for SEK 350. You will have a map in your conference bag when you check in at the hotel. Check in starts at 11 am.

In the evening we will have a get together at 8 pm. It is NOT a dinner, just something to drink and snacks. Meet old friends and have a nice time!

The agenda for the Conference will be sent to you from the Europe Committee. Already at 10am you can have a cup of coffee at the Stockholm City Conference Centre (CCC) and meet your delegation. The conference starts at 11am; you will have lunch and afternoon coffee at CCC and dinner at the hotel in the evening. If you have not told us any food restrictions so far, please do so, we have to alert the restaurant and hotel!

Sunday the 8th we are back in Stockholm and the bus will take us to the main Railway Station. If you want to stay another night in Stockholm and would like some information about what is on, please let us know.
