Plan for 2016-2018

After three years of successful work, the Europe Committee is glad to present the priorities and goals defined for the next triennium (2016-2018).

Even though some of the Committee members will change, we believe it is important to continue in the same path as defined, in order to promote continuous development of our Region. The plan herein is sufficiently broad and flexible to embrace other opportunities that may be open, as well as new ideas that can, meanwhile, be brought to the attention of the Committee.

The first priority is to maintain close relationship with NSGF's, European members in the Central Branch, and the Sub-Regions, and provide help and support according to the needs.

For that purpose the Europe Committee intends to: collect material about success stories on how to recruit new members, and produce a report with examples to serve as inspiration to others; encourage member countries to closer work with the Guides and Scouts, using opportunities such as the Peace Light of Bethlehem to get more visibility and recruit new and younger members; encourage the members to make use of the ISGF kit; encourage twinning between guilds locally and internationally, etc.

The Europe Committee feels that information is often scarce and scattered, therefore, we intend to produce a summary of info of all countries in the Region: members, activities, etc. In order to do so, it is important that NSGF's will check and update the contents of their profiles. This will allow the Europe Committee to also keep the Europe Region profile updated on the Website.

Another priority is to maintain sound accounting rules and procedures, and produce an annual accounts report to be sent to the member-countries. Also the minutes of the Europe Committee Meetings are to be sent to the member-countries, upon approval by all the Committee members.

The Newsletter will continue to be produced and circulated whenever there are matters of interest to the Region, together with an updated Event Calendar, so that everyone is in tune with the Region developments and activities.

We are already planning the 7th Europe Workshop, as privileged space for Europe members, and others that wish to join, to share information and exchange ideas as best practices. The Committee will also be engaged and supporting the organising team of the 10th Europe Conference, and will actively participate in the ISGF World Conference, to be held in Indonesia in 2018.

We are certain we will be able to count on each and every one of you to help us have another successful three years of work in favour of the Europe Region, and ISGF as a whole.
