# The new ISGF global project in cooperation with UNHCR in Uganda

South Sudanese people, facing conflicts in the Great Lakes region and suffering from famine in South Sudan, are forced to flee and to seek refuge at Imvepi in North-West Uganda, at an altitude of 730 metres. Every day, the refugee settlement received thousands of desperate persons, mostly women and children who had to leave everything behind them to save their lives. Normally each family is given either a tent or tumpline for them to construct hats to live in. However, the situation at Imvepi is so critical that not all refugees can get a shelter and their living conditions are very precarious, they lack the basic needs. The first need is a shelter because:





- A shelter is a determining factor for the survival of a population affected at the beginning of a disaster.
- A shelter is essential to give security, personal security, protection against climate and prevention of epidemics.
- A shelter is also important for the individual human dignity and to allow the affected population to recover from the impact of the disasters.

They need our support. A shelter for one family costs 25€ and the ISGF objective is to provide shelters to 1,000 families in cooperation with the UNHCR in Uganda. We call on your contributions, whatever the amount is, any donation is a valuable gift for them. **ISGF UNHCR PARTNERSHIP**

#### **News from Australia**

Nationally there are over 2000 members in Australia from the east coast to the west coast. This means a large variety of service activities are undertaken.

Service to the community includes the St George Guild in New South Wales visiting Nursing Homes and singing Christmas carols and Irish songs.

The Queensland Guilds supported the "Heart of Australia" campaign which delivers specialist heart cardiology services to the remote outback on a truck called the Heart Bus. Queensland also supported the drought relief effort in that state that helped both farmers and rural store owners.

Western Australia Guilds contributed funds to the Nepal Earthquake Appeal.

The Trefoil Guild of Australia made very generous donations to State, Australian and International Community projects. Service from the Trefoil Guilds also included supplying items for children in Westmead hospital in New South Wales (Ward Angels) and selling dried fruit to raise money for an Outreach Fund. This is in addition to the donations of food to women's shelters and the Salvation Army and knitted items for premature babies and dementia patients. The Trefoil Guild also contributed to Riding for the Disabled, Mercy Ships, Anglicare and Blue Care.

Scouting and Guiding was certainly not forgotten with terrific support from Guilds for events across the country such as Scout Hike in Victoria and Cubilee in Western Australia and the Guide's Agoonoree. The Trefoil Guilds also strongly supported State Girl Guides, International Girl Guides and Trefoil Guild Projects with funding. A Victorian Baden-Powell Scout Guild ran a food van for Surfmoot and Mudbash for Rovers and Trefoil Guilds made a donation to Fiji Guides and Kiribati Guides.
