VISIT TO NICOSIA

Nicosia is the capital city of Cyprus. It is the brightest capital of Europe with over 300 days of sunshine annually.

Nicosia's illustrious history and geographical uniqueness have made it a **crossroads** for some of history's most important civilizations. Imprints left by greats such as the Ptolemies, Romans and the Byzantines, the Franks, Venetians, Ottomans and finally the British may be encountered in one's travels through the **Old Town** area of Nicosia.

Nicosia is surrounded by Walls which were built by the Franks in the 16th century after the Lusignan kings arrived on the island. The Venetians realized that the walls did not offer adequate protection from invaders and tore them down, replacing them with the walls that remain until present day. The Ottomans repaired the Walls and covered them with stones during their occupation of Nicosia. Until today, the Walls are the most well – preserved construction in the city.



All above can be seen through a walk around the city where we will travel through time. In “Laiki Gitonia” we will have the opportunity to see remarkable examples of traditional urban architecture as well as small art workshops.
