Visa Requirement

Greece is a Member-State of the European Union and has signed the Schengen Agreement since 1997.

Citizens of the Member States of the European Union and of the Schengen Agreement have the right to travel to Greece and the rest of the Schengen area by simply displaying their identity card or passport.

Visas are not required by European citizens from countries that are part of the Schengen Area. Greece as a member of the Schengen Agreement has abolished controls at air and sea borders for countries of the Schengen area and allows Member-State citizens to travel around without a visa for a short stay period of up to three (3) months.

Citizens coming from countries that have not yet joined Schengen Area **may require a visa to enter Greece**. The E.U. visitors from these countries can acquire further information from the Hellenic Embassies or Consulates in their countries, or from their travel agencies.
