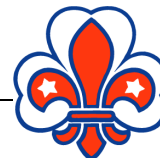

	Any main and/or local activities?
	National Bi-annual Assembly held 15-19 September 2021. New National Committee elected. Celebration of 50 years ownership of Kvernmoen scout campsite was held in June. Due to restriction rules in public transport, Peace Light distribution was very limited in 2021, but Peace Light sermons were held in Oslo, Hamar and Bergen. A Peace Light flame is now continually burning in convents in Bergen and Oslo. The number of traditional fellowship meetings was restricted but were to some extent replaced by out-door meetings and walks.
	Cooperation and support to Scouting and Guiding in your country, any national / local activities?
	We own and operate the Kvernmoen scout campsite in southeastern Norway, with a capacity of some 400-450 scouts. It is used for regional camps and troop camps, as well as other activities like JOTA (Jamboree-on-the-air). The national scout camp that was planned for 2021 was replaced by a number of smaller, regional camps. Guild members participated as support staff in some of them. Locally, support was given on a more usual scale, much of it as technical assistance with maintenance of scout cabins and houses.
	Any involvement in community service?
	Our efforts in community work is limited, and is mainly given as support to local charities.
	Any international dimension in celebrating Fellowship Day, St Georges Day, Founders Day/World Thinking Day, Peace Light etc?
	World Thinking Day, St. Georges Day and Fellowship Day are commonly celebrated locally.
	What did you do to increase membership?
	The very high average ages in most existing guilds make them less attractive to potential new, younger members
	Do you collect stamps for the ISGF Stamp Bank?

A few guilds have twinning. Some of them are still active, but not all. For the last fifteen years, most of our international contact has been with Pigeon Park in Nyeri, Kenya.
