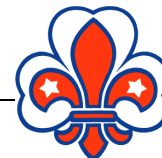

<b>Present a brief comment on your 2020 main activities</b>	
In 2020, due to pandemic restrictions, traditional activities were limited to on-line contacts mainly. Senior members were encouraged to stay at home. So they were offered help by young ZHP leaders.	
<b>Your cooperation and support to Scouting and Guiding in your country, any activities?</b>	
Some adult scouts and guides were preparing materials and were engaged in online activities run by scouts and guides in the framework of their respective local groups. They also offered assistance (limited by circumstances) in training courses for young leaders. Only few summer camps were organized and even fewer seniors attended them.

Individual adult scouts and guides supported local charities, offering distribution and delivery of food during the pandemic. They helped in logistics.

<b>Did you organize fundraising events?</b>
Yearly tradition to participate in December/January fundraising of the Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity on the local communities level. Funds were raised to finance equipment for hospitals. Numerous seniors offered 1% of their personal income tax to be used by ZHP as well as promoted the idea among their fellow citizens.
