Związek Harcerstwa Polskiego podejmuje służbę pomocy Ukrainie

Już od pierwszych chwil wybuchu wojny, rozpoczęliśmy działania na rzecz pomocy ofiarom agresji rosyjskiej na Ukrainę. Powołaliśmy sztab i oficjalnie uruchamiamy akcję "ZHP dla Ukrainy", której zadaniem jest koordynacja wszelkich, prowadzonych przez jednostki organizacyjne Związku Harcerstwa Polskiego, działań pomocowych na terenie Polski.

Na tej stronie dowiesz się co robimy i jak możesz pomóc. Do włączenia się do naszych akcji zachęcamy nie tylko harcerki i harcerzy ZHP – ale każdego, komu los poszkodowanych leży na sercu.

"W zgodzie z hasłem "Myśl globalnie, działaj lokalnie" zachęcamy przede wszystkim do dotarcia do pomocy w Waszych miastach/gminach/powiatach. W większości z nich są już zorganizowane sztaby pomocowe. Śledźcie media społecznościowe i informacje Waszych lokalnych samorządów - tam włączajcie się do pomagania na zgłaszane prośby."

Examples of involvement of Adult Scouts and Guides Fellowships in helping Ukraine

Lublin Region

„Szaniec” Fellowship in Lublin – physical-animation-integration activities for several children from Ukraine aged 7-10, collection of donations: food, bandages, blankets and handing them over to Polish Red Cross (75 kg).

„Skaut” Fellowship in Chełm – help with sorting donations

„Korzenie” and „Zawisza Czarny” Fellowships in Gdańsk - on duty at the Scout House, prepare and serve meals, organise day care for young children

Examples of involvement of Adult Scouts and Guides Fellowships in helping Ukraine

Lower Silesia Region (Wrocław Region)

all Fellowships organise collection of necessary items such as clothes, bedding, hygiene products, food, toys for children, necessities; in addition

„Rodło” in Wrocław – they are on duty at the Main Railway Station, serve hot meals, direct people to accommodation, look after children

„Korzenie” in Lubań – they help at the orphanage where the refugees have been accommodated

„Złota Lilijka” in Jawor – they are on duty at the Humanitarian Aid Centre, they give out food parcels and clothes, direct people to accommodation points

„Wiarusy” in Świdnica – they are on duty at the refugee aid station, which was set up at Świdnica ZHP District HQ, they help to pack and sort goods, organise activities for children from Ukraine

Examples of involvement of Adult Scouts and Guides Fellowships in helping Ukraine

Wielkopolska Region (Poznań Region)

OWAR Fellowship in Poznań – old scouts together with young scouts receive, sort and prepare for shipment donations brought to Central Collection Point for Ukraine which is arranged on the premises of Poznań International Fair

"10 PDH i Wiarusy" in Poznań – they prepared packages for Ukrainian children, bandages and medicines for the front pharmacy, members of the Fellowship took care of three families from Ukraine

"Płomienie" in Czerwonak - they donated bedding, sleeping bags, durable foodstuffs and cleaning products to the aid station for Ukraine, sorted and prepared the gifts for distribution, collected and deposited cash on the account of the aid fund for Ukraine, several members declared their willingness to host refugees under their roof

"Wiarusy" in Września – they joined in the activities of the District Aid Point for Ukraine - sorting and packing foodstuffs and cleaning products, distributing gifts to needy Ukrainians

Examples of involvement of Adult Scouts and Guides Fellowships in helping Ukraine

Wielkopolska Region (Poznań Region) cont.

Fellowship in Kościan - they brought 3 families from the border by cars, organized free transport of Ukrainian children to schools, bought and donated necessary items

"Krąg Bratnich Rąk" in Nowy Tomyśl – Ex-teachers volunteer to teach Polish language, carry out "parcel for refugee" campaign

"Szóstacy" in Poznań - collection of needed items and collection of money for school supplies for Ukrainian children

Examples of involvement of Adult Scouts and Guides Fellowships in helping Ukraine

Kielce Region

„Łysica-Zegary” Fellowship in Jędrzejów – charity collection in shopping centres, mainly food and personal items, collecting money during the charity concert "Jędrzejow for Ukraine", giving school supplies to children from the Kiev area who are now in the local school: toiletries and school supplies, notebooks, balls, toys, sweets.

Head of the Fellowship met with students in the primary school and encouraged them to organise help for refugee children and establish direct, cordial contacts with them.
