With this the 1st session concluded.

Constitutional amendments and conduct of fresh Elections/Nominations at the next Gathering at Penang was also deliberated upon. The Foundation Report was shared on the screen for all the members. And questions raised by Members were taken up and answered. Discussion on the next Gathering took place and Indonesia expressed their willing to host the same. However, it was suggested that the new committee should decide and other countries who are interested to host may also give their presentation at Penang.

The meeting concluded with listing out the upcoming events of SDG training on 28th May 2022 and the 11th AsPac Committee Meeting which will tentatively be in March/April, 2023.

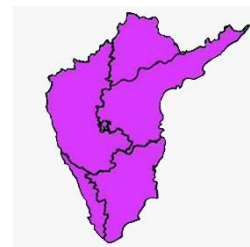
