Fraternity by Nuno Alvares, Portugal. The Radio Scouting Days 2025, organized by the National Radio Scouting Department of the National Scouting Corps, took place on March 8 and 9, at the National Scouting Park of the Costa da Caparica (PNEC), in the Setúbal region.

The Journadas are an annual activity in the CNE calendar, characterized by technical sessions, with the two components of this department the radio and the internet.

The Programme was based on current topics of general interest and was organized in a way to create educational opportunities for participants to dialogue, convey, deepen and share knowledge.

The Journadas are an activity open to all sections, with workshops suitable for the age or level of knowledge of the participants. This year, besides the elements representing all sections of the CNE, had the presence of elements from the Scout Association of Portugal and the Fraternity by Nuno Alvares. Participants from various points of mainland Portugal were present including a strong representation of the Azores (Third Island), from the Vitória Beach Group. This island team included some young radio amateur scouts (12 and 16) who took the radio amateur exam a week ago.

The Journadas were a moment of great information sharing and socializing, with the FNA associates participating, contributing to the success of this activity.




From March 3rd to 6th, as a member of the MASCI Italian Catholic Scout Adult Movement, I took part in a mission to Kharkiv, a Ukrainian city about 20 kilometers from the front line, with the Italian delegation of MEAN European Nonviolent Action Movement, which aims to promote the creation of the Civil Peace Corps recently discussed by the European Parliament.

Due to the proximity of the front line, drones, alarms and missiles make social activities practically impossible, but we found in the institutions and in the people a strong spirit and will to resist and to rebuild.

We met the Latin Catholic and Greek Catholic bishops, who showed us how the collection of basic necessities and aid is organised. We were welcomed by the acting rector of the University of Urban Economy, Ihor Biletskyi. The university had been bombed in the early stages of the war. We discussed possible forms and levels of support for the further restoration of the university.

We visited the Museum of Arts, where the director, Valentina Myzgina, showed us the war damage and the masterpieces that had been brought to safety. The famous conductor Yuriy Yanko showed us the Drama Theatre, which has been empty for three years. The girls of the Olympic synchronised swimming team welcomed us in the elegant hall of the Diplomatic Club. They managed to train in Kharkiv.

In the shelter of the cathedral, we met the girl scouts. Their headquarters had been hit by a drone the week before. The Karchiv scout group consists of about 100 people.

At this difficult moment, everyone is asking us to keep in touch with them and help them rebuild. If the war ends soon, as we all hope, the main needs will be the restoration of civilian infrastructure, economic activity and jobs, and education.
