<p>Communication</p>	<p>Improving Communication is our priority</p> <p>This will include communication within our membership, with Scouting, Guiding, our Partners, the wider world of ISGF and our communities. We will be very proactive in contacting NSGF's to collect information and also in its distribution to all members, through their NP & IS, ISGF membership throughout the world through the World Bureau, ISGF website, and sharing our News with WAGGGS and WOSM through their Europe Region Offices.</p> <p>HOW:</p> <p>Have an online calendar on which each NSGF will be encouraged to put their events & meetings</p> <p>Have a Europe Region Facebook page on which all NSGF's will be encouraged to post items</p> <p>Committee will invite NP, IS or a representative from each NSGF to meetings every 3 months, and to take part in the meeting.</p> <p>Circulate approved Minutes to all NP & IS</p> <p>Newsletter – improve. Calendar, Events, Projects, People to be published 4 times a year.</p> <p>Action 2024/25:</p> <p>Minutes of the Europe Conference were published in October 2023.</p> <p>Minutes of the Europe Committee for November 2024; January, February, March, June and August 2025 have been published.</p> <p>Newsletters were published in: August, September, November, and December 2024; February, April, May and November 2025.</p> <p><u>All these items have also been published on the ISGF website.</u></p> <p>A Europe Newsletter Distribution list has been established to ensure a copy of the Newsletter goes to WOSM and WAGGGS.</p> <p>NP and IS were invited to Europe Committee meetings in March and June 2025</p> <p>ISGF Europe Region Facebook page was set up in October 2023. More members need to join as it has lots of interesting information from all round the world of Scouting and Guiding.</p> <p>Calendar – so far we have not found a way of sharing this online.</p>
<p>Visibility</p>	<p>This should result from better communication and publicity</p> <p>We will be collecting information to ensure that NSGF Profiles are up to date on the ISGF website. We will be improving the communication and relationships with WAGGGS, WOSM, in the Europe Region. We will be improving the visibility of ISGF in the Europe Region by ensuring publication of information through the Newsletter, Social Media, (websites/facebook) and encouraging NSGF's to take part in the distribution of the Peacelight, publicising their Events and Projects.</p>

	<p>HOW: Update profiles on ISGF website, Region, Sub-Region, National Partnerships – make a list of all Partnerships within the Region, encourage all NSGF's to support Partnerships. Projects – collecting and publishing information on what Projects NSGF's are working on. Support NSGF's and Sub Regions to organise events.</p> <p>Action 2024/25: Visibility of the Europe Region has improved through use of the ISGF Europe Region Facebook page, publication of the Newsletter on both the Facebook page and the ISGF Website. More members need to look at these. Sue Page had an online meeting with the Europe Regional Director of WOSM. We need to send her information on what service we are giving to Scouting in Europe, including financial help. WAGGGS. No contact yet, letters sent 24.3.25 – awaiting reply. PROJECTS. We need more of our organisations to send in their Project forms, including Partnership information and Peacelight participation. EVENTS. Support has been offered to all members organising Gatherings in 2025 and Conference in 2026. This support will be ongoing with a view to making the events more accessible and affordable for members to attend. PROFILES. The Europe Region and all Sub Region Profiles have been updated on the ISGF website. The Profiles for some Europe countries are out of date, some by as much as 9 years. Some Europe Region Countries have NOT sent in their Annual Report. The information for the Profiles is taken from this. PLEASE send in your Annual Report to the World Bureau.</p>
<p>Membership</p>	<p>To maintain the current level of membership. This will need NSGF's to recruit new members.</p> <p>HOW: Look at those NSGF's which have increased their membership and learn from them. Increased publicity and communication will help. Review all governance for the Region and update where necessary.</p> <p>Membership looks to be slightly down, but it is almost impossible to tell as not all NSGF's have informed us of their latest membership numbers. Sue Page has a good relationship with the World Bureau and we exchange information, so if you have sent in your membership numbers on your Annual Report, we will get an update.</p>
<p>Who</p>	<p>Europe Region Committee: Officers, as elected by their Sub Regions, plus members Co-opted to carry out specific jobs. Sub Region committees and NP & IS of all NSGF's in the Region. Sue Page resigned in September 2024 following her election to the World Committee. She was replaced by Oihana La Guardia to represent WESR. Sue then volunteered to become our Minute Secretary. Oihana resigned and was replaced by Marisca Kamperman to represent the WESR. Marisca took up office in Oct. 2025 and her term of office will end in 2028. Sara Milreau was elected to represent the SESR and will take up office in March 2026, but will be invited to meetings with immediate effect. Her term of office will complete in 2028. We would also be happy to Co-opt any member who wanted a specific role on the committee. We will need a Minute Secretary from March 2026 as Sue cannot carry on after that date.</p>
