It consists of a circle with a pentagon inside, within which we can see: the badge of AISG-ISGF, the figure chosen to represent our most genuine attitude (the **Hornero**) and the motto we have chosen

The light blue color within the circle symbolizes ISGF-ISGF and Uruguay as well.

The pentagon represents the 5th Gathering and the Beige color within it symbolizes the color of FASGU's uniform

El **Hornero** (*Furnarius Rufus*), is a typical bird of the Pampas region and Uruguay, who lives in couples in their

state-of-the-art mud-built nest. Their remarkable attitudes are Endeavour, Commitment, Skillfulness and Teamwork, predominant values in Scouting.

The ComOrg want to express our wish to meet you and we are trying to foresee every step we take, down to the smallest detail, so that you can share with us 3 days of knowing each other, learning and fun. That is why, until next September 30 we continue to receive registrations.

As previously explained, the cost for each participant will be USD 320 per person in a five-fold base, USD 420 per person in double basis and USD 520 in case of preferring a single room. The cost includes accommodation for three nights (days 1, 2 and 3 November 2018) in the Hildebrando Berenguer - Salinas Complex, with twelve meals (3 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 3 snacks and 3 dinners), transportation, materials of work and a tour to Montevideo to be done on Saturday, November 3.

Payments must be made in US Dollars, free of costs or commissions to:
