

## ISGF World Conference 2021

After consultation with the Host Committee and the World Committee Conference Team the following terms and conditions shall now apply to World Conference 2021.

The payment plan and cancellation policy have been adjusted:

20% before 15 May 2021 (was 15 February)

50% by 15 June 2021 (was 15 May)

After June 15 (was 15 May) there will be no refunds

NB: The registration can be applied to another person not previously registered, without any cost.

If World Conference 2021 is prevented from carrying out its obligations because of COVID-19 the following costs will be deducted from the received amount.

- 1. Bank transfer expenses
- 2. Currency conversion (if any)
- 3. 3% for compensation for cancellation

Unfortunately, the main focus was to assess covid-19 impact all around the World, however a very positive attitude was taken by all the attendees. The Region decided to go ahead with all the arrangements for the Region. The Committee greeted observers from Myanmar and Brunei who are currently working towards ISGF membership.

In June, the Committee held their meeting on Zoom and asked all AsPac NSGFs what would be the better option

for the 16<sup>th</sup> AsPac regional Conference: to go ahead in 2021 or to postpone to 2022. In October, it was decided for the Conference to be held on the 25<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> November in Penang, Malaysia. It is 4 months later than originally planned to count on the possibility that international travel will be advisable by then. Malaysia is working hard to host a great conference. The arrangements and the costing will be available after the next Committee meeting on the 14<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Brian Jackson would like to thank NSGFs that assisted with humanitarian aid related to covid-19 in the worst affected countries within AsPac Region. Their efforts and their work are highly appreciated. For instance, the Maldives NSGF distributed 1400 surgical masks to frontline workers in their capital Male.


**Strategic Plan.** In June, the committee approved a strategic plan for 2019-2022.

**Guests** Representatives of the NSGFs and Central Branch groups are invited to each monthly meeting, for the committee to learn first-hand about their activities and needs and for the national organizations to learn about the support the committee can offer them as well as the committee's projects.

Since this committee was installed in September 2019, the following members have participated: Anand Rameshwar Singh from ISGF- TT (Trinidad & Tobago); Oscar Ibañez from ASGACH (Chile); Jorge Nilo Iglesias from AASGC (Cuba / USA); Jamilie Haile and Solange López from Copernicia (Curaçao); Eustace Ward and four other members from ANSGA (Panama); Alejandro Bargallo from ANASMAC (Mexico).

#### Performed activities

1. On the occasion of the 4th Anniversary of the Western Hemisphere Region, on September 5, a successful Zoom meeting was held, gathering more than 50 members from 14 countries.



- 2. On October 25, the anniversary of ISGF, a flyer was published in the WhatsApp groups inviting members of the Region to make a Fellow's Phone Call to a member of another country, to strengthen personal ties.
- 3. On November 7, a Concrete Action was organized, based on the proposals made by the participants in the 2nd Conference of the Western Hemisphere Region. Seven NSGFs and groups from the Central Branch participated.

## Scheduled activity.

On December 12, the regional committee convened national organizations to carry out an end-of-year activity, called Solidarity Day, consisting of donating non-perishable food and toys to those in need on the occasion of the end of the year's festivities.

#### Central America and the Caribbean Sub Region.

On November 11, a Zoom meeting was held with representatives of Mexico, Curaçao, Panama, Trinidad - Tobago, Guatemala and Suriname, along with the President and Secretary of the Committee of the Western Hemisphere Region. The intention was to carry out preliminary conversations to create a new Sub Region. The outcomes were very encouraging as the participants demonstrated enthusiasm and vocation to advance in this Sub Regional organization.

## **Development of National Organizations.**

Despite the Covid-19, during 2020 the Region grew at a good pace, and the committee carried out a specific task of accompaniment, support and facilitation to the following countries:

1. In Guatemala, a new group (ATZ FSGG) was created in September and consolidated in November, with more than 150 members.



2. ANSGA (Panama) returned to ISGF activities in the Region, after some years of absence.



- 3. In Peru and Chile, there are vibrant Central Branch groups that are developing and increasing their membership to finally become NSGFs in their respective countries.
- 4. The NSGF-AMO of Argentina (SGAA) is growing its membership in order to become a Full Member at the 29th World Conference Madrid 2021
- 5. The Central Branch's groups of Brazil (ABAEB), Suriname (PAVEURS) and Venezuela (FASGV) have their legal procedures well advanced with ISGF Legal Team, to become Full Members in Madrid 2021.

In short, 2020's challenges became opportunities of development for the WHR
