Sixty Years in Service to the Scout Movement

The Passing of the Scout Movement's Prince

The Arabian scout movement were shocked by the passing of prince Yousef Dandan, who passed away and left us a priceless inheritance. It was painful for everyone to hear about the loss of the founder of The Arabian Scout Pioneers and Guides Union, who made great efforts to establish the union.

He's considered one of the pillars of the scout movement in the Arab world, and one of the biggest founders of the Arabian Scout Pioneers and Guides Union, where he discussed with the secretary general of the scout commission Mr. Fouzi Farghali, the practical step to execute the testimonials of the successive scout conferences, and it ended with the 16th Arabian Scout Conference happening in Masqat, from December 5th to 11th 1984.

While the conference took place, three different meetings were held, where Dandan presented the primary system for the union. And after deliberations, the founding commission was picked, and the prince was named as general secretary in it. He suggested that the headquarters should be in the Jordanian Capital until things are stable.



In 1999 to 2010, as he also attended all Arabian Scout conferences since the 16th one in 1984 to 23rd in Saudi Arabia 2001. And the prince spent more than 60 years in the movement. He was born in Lebanon 1937, and gave a lot to the field of scout movement.

In Lebanon. In another sitting that took place in 8/12/1984, the prince announced the rise of the Arabian Union of Old Scouts and Guides, and as a result, we saw the prince attend all conferences since the first one from 1995 to 2010, as he also attended the Arabian Meetings for the scout pioneers since it's first one

He took the burden of serving the scout movement through the activities of it's pioneers, where he spent most of life ready for the activities and scout programs. He was affiliated with the Muslim Scout Association in 1948, and joined the arabian scout camp in 1954 in Syria, and 1956 in Egypt. In 1957, it was his turn in Lebanon and he got high leading positions in the association. In 1973, he became a member of the preparing commission for scout camps in Lebanon, and then the leader of the scout camp in 1974. And he established the Arabian Union for Scout Pioneers and Guides, and announced the document of establishment in the 16th Scout Conference in Masqat, Oman 1984. He received the commission's golden distinction in 1988, and many other distinctions and certifications, most notably the Arabian Scout Necklace in 1995, Tunisia. And he got a distinction from the Lebanese government in 1998.

The great leader who used to works out differences with the scout leaders, and who was greatly informed about the history of all things related to the Arabian Scout, has passed away.
