**1<sup>st</sup> day** 16<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021 - began early with tea and peaceful ambience of the campsite. Due to employment Shift timings and location restrictions and the challenges in transporting Men and Materials to a High altitude region. The team was divided into two, the first team reported at the rendezvous point, Union Metro- Bus Station, and joined with Mr. Prince Hamza at 18:00 Hrs of 25th Feb.

The second team traveled to Ras Al Khaimah, Bus Station, and was joined by Mr. Isaq NI. All participants reached the final camping point by 00:30 Hrs 26th Feb.

Upon reaching the camp location, the seasoned scouts quickly sat up the tent and the camp kitchen, there was a permanent latrine facility provided by the Government of Ras Al Khaimah, for the tourists camping in the mountain. Apart from the Campfire lighting, Additional LED lights were employed for a general increase of camping efficiency in the darkness. A charcoal fire was used to prepare the dinner.

Life skills from scouting and how they helped us as an ex-pat was discussed over the campfire dinner. The general takeaway from the discussion is that scouting prepared us to tackle the challenges of ex-pat life and the pandemic year The Camp Fire was set off by 02:00 Hrs. Everyone enjoyed the experience of sleeping in a tent with the teammates after many months.

The next day started for us at 07:00 Hrs, due to cold weather the fitness routine was rescheduled, After the morning routines, the kitchen fire was set up and breakfast was being made. At the breakfast, A zoom meeting was set up, which was unusual for such an altitude, at 10:00 Hrs, honorable National Secretary, Mr. Mecci was joined with us from Korea, in the meeting The SGF LOGO was unveiled and the certificates for all camp members were distributed.

After breakfast, the tent was cleaned and everyone went for a hike, navigating over rocky terrain to the nearby clearing on the top of the cliff, there Mr. Prince Hamza demonstrated a breathing exercise that benefits the lowers lungs.

The temperature dropped suddenly after 12:00 Hrs, on our way back to the camp location, we had the opportunity to interact with an Air Force Captain, who also preferred to set up camp in the High Atitude point. We prepared tea and after refreshments, everyone started clearing the camping spot and packing their bags. The kitchen was packed back into the car, finally, the Tent was brought down and carefully packed in the bags. We started our descent from the mountains by 14:00 Hrs, we made sure nothing but thanks were left.

We used the opportunity to discuss the future path and programs of the Guild, its digital space presence, and opportunities to do service in the ex-pat life. We also utilized the opportunity to hear the insights from Mr. Sijin Sivadas, who had more experience in the management of Guild units and their digital presence. Our camp officially dispersed at Abu Hail Metro Station, Dubai.
