National Updates:

15th National Gathering - 7th to 9th January 2022

The 15th National Gathering of the Indian Scout & Guide Fellowship was held from 07th to 09th January 2022, at Alwar, Rajasthan hosted by Rajasthan State SGF and co-hosted by Alwar District SGF. With the third wave of Covid-19 sweeping across the country, and multiple concerns of Covid related restrictions being freshly imposed in the state of Rajasthan, it was held in a scaled down manner as the number of registrants had crossed 200 and the situation

warranted holding the gathering restricting the numbers to 100. Many participants had cancelled their travel plans due to the situation. However, the coordinating team of NHQ with the able support of the convenor and the team of Alwar District SGF members, conducted the gathering on the scheduled days, in keeping with the theme of the gathering 'SURVIVAL'.

Pre-gathering meeting at venue: 06.01.2022: Team members of NHQ led by Secretary General, Seema Rathi arrived at the venue in the morning of 06.01.2022 and met with the members of the Alwar team led by H C Kalra to finalize the logistics and programs of the gathering consequent to the revision in numbers permitted for gathering in the new guidelines of Rajasthan State. All the preparation work for welcoming the participants were put in place. And many participants started arriving by the evening of 6th January 2022.

Day 1: 07.01.2022:

The day began at 08.30 AM with prayers, offered to the almighty seeking blessings for unhindered and successful conduct of the gathering. At 09.00 AM, the gathering team met again to ascertain the preparedness of all the sub-committees and any other requirements. Registrations began simultaneously. All the participants were requested to undergo RT-PCR tests and then welcomed in traditional Rajasthani way, with tilak and sweets. Kits containing, required articles like note-pad, pen, SGF scarf and masks were provided. It was a colourful and festive atmosphere and all the participants experienced the warm hospitality given to them. At 10.00 AM the National Council Meeting was convened by Seema Rathi Secretary General, chaired by Sampath Kothari, Internal Auditor Indian SGF and attended by Diana E Kharshiing, International Secretary, Padmini Pillai, National Treasurer, Dr Deepak Patel-National Coordinator, Dr Amol Kalekar, Udit Choubisa, and all the agenda points were discussed and minutes drawn and approved by Honourable Chief Justice Rtd. Kalpesh Jhaveri President in Chief Indian SGF & Gathering Chief.

After registrations and lunch, all the participants gathered for the Integration Programme at 2.00 PM. A brief introduction about Alwar was beautifully given by Girish Yadav of NWR Railway SGF. He gave interesting trivia of the history and culture of Alwar. This was followed by a talk by Secretary General Seema Rathi in which she explained about the theme for this gathering, 'Survival'. She pointed out that all participants have lived through the theme to reach the venue. In times of adversity and uncertainty, to be able to stay composed and overcome the situation rather than panicking is survival and that way, everyone present has survived adversity to reach and participate in the gathering. This was followed by a self-introduction session. State-wise introduction of members took place. Sujaya from Karnataka State SGF briefed the participants of the schedule for the next three days, giving a brief idea of what would be required from the participants for each activity. Dr Amol Kalekar advised the participants about the care and precautions to be taken for the health and well-being of the participants in view of the situation. Dr Deepak Patel gave a brief about the instructions regarding exercising restraint on publicity and media, especially on social media. As there were guidelines in place, it was imperative to ensure that SGF is seen to be complying with the law and guidelines in public and social media. Only official photographs taken by the organizing team were to be shared on social media. The gathering took a break for Tea.

Everyone gathered again at 4.00 PM for the Inaugural Function. Inauguration Function was started with Assembly and Scout Guide Prayer, Diana E Kharshiing paid tributes to the SGF members who lost their lives during the past year and a minute's silence was observed in respect. This was followed by lighting lamp. Chief Guest for the occasion was Shri Nanumal Pahadiya, the Collector of Alwar District and Guest of Honor was Ms. Tejasvini Gautam, Supt. of Police. The occasion was concluded in Presidentship of Gathering Chief Honourable Chief Justice Rtd Kalpesh Jhaveri. Madhu Kalia, Advisor Ind.SGF gave the welcome address which was followed by a beautiful welcome dance. The Chief Guest addressed Gathering and remembered his own time as a boy Scout and the Scout Guide prayer. He expressed happiness and gave his blessings. Justice Kalpesh Jhaveri delivered inaugural address for the gathering, which was followed by Blessings from Khillimal Jain. After this, there was a 'smarika vimochan' (Event souvenir) where a Smarika was released by Alwar District SGF. A small program of birthday celebration organized for Justice Kalpesh Jhaveri, as part of the celebration, apart from cake-cutting, 60-year pins and life/donor member badges were distributed to the eligible participants. Group photo was taken in the garden and Justice Jhaveri presented scarves to New Divyang Guild members from Alwar District, followed by hi-tea.

At 5.00 PM, Entertainment program began with group dance on song - Ute sabke kadam..... Girish Yadav kept everyone in an enjoyable and cheerful mood. Harshad Ismail conducted quiz and prizes were given away to the winners. Harshad also presented a small video showcasing the 5th Adventure Camp held at Pilikula, Mangalore, during February 2021. The entertainment programs continued until 7.00 PM, followed by dinner.

At 8.00 PM, Cultural Evening began. This program was organized by the Alwar SGF team. A team of internationally acclaimed artists were invited, including well-renowned poet Vineet Chowhan, Mathadeen and party with their local folk art and song, young talent Yousaf Khan and party with their enthralling music and variety entertainment, Bane Singh Prajapath and Praveen Prajapath who were able to keep the audience at the edge of the seat with thrilling performances. The whole event was colourful and vibrant and seemed to transform the audience into a sublime and spiritual world of art and culture. Audiences became performers themselves as the music and dance unified everybody's minds and souls. Not a minute of the entire program could be missed.

First day closed with announcement for next day schedule and working team meeting held for next day preparations, work was lined up. Meeting hall was cleaned and sanitized for next day.

Day 2: 08.01.2022:

The second day began at 7.00 AM with a yoga session. Started by Amit Mandal, SER SGF, Kharagpur, it was then taken over by Yogacharya Sanjay Kumar Agarwal and Hina Gupta from Bharatiya Yog Sansthan, a 50 year old organization based in Alwar. Simple yoga practices were demonstrated and members were guided to do them along with explanation about the

benefit of these practices. Advice about doing every day for health and well-being was shared by them. After yoga session, there was a break for freshen up and breakfast.

Assembled at 09.30 for the day's proceedings. Started with 'Shradanjali' to mark the day of Lord Baden Powell's death anniversary in the presence of Justice Kalpesh Jhaveri, Gathering Chief. It was a solemn function where all the participants carried little lamps and accompanied the Chief Guest into the hall and then placed them before the picture of Lord Baden Powell to pay their respects. It was unique because normally only his birthday is observed all over as 'thinking day'. After Prayer and announcements for the day and updates by Diana E Kharshiing about the General Council Meeting held on 07th Jan 2022, proceeded to the state-wise presentations of reports of activities undertaken during the past year. The states whose members could not travel due to the current situation shared their presentations virtually. All the reports showcased service activities of members, which resulted in a sharing of ideas and future planning, followed by ATAS Gathering. Justice Kalpesh Jhaveri President ATAS India presented ATAS patches to all members and congratulate them, Group Photograph was taken with ATAS Members. And this program was followed by lunch, everyone enjoyed the Rajasthani food Dal – Baati – Choorma.

At 2.30 PM, stalls were set up for the Fellowship Bazaar, where states put up their special cuisines and artefacts for sale. The Special guests for the bazaar were Satyanarayan Sharma, Patron Indian SGF & Vice President BS&G and Krishna Murari Gangavat, former MP, Thanagaji, Alwar. Alongside the stalls, other members participated in slogan-writing and fancy-dress activities, 12 members participated in fancy dress activity & had enjoyment. It was an afternoon full of colors and fun with traditions of India.

At 5.00 PM, assembled for Youth Day celebration and recognitions. President Executive M.A.K.Mecci joined this programme virtually from South Korea and his presence made the gathering light up in anticipation and excitement for his talk. Introducing, the importance of Swami Vivekananda and relevance of his teachings to this day by Aditya Agrawal and Satyanarayan Sharma, Patron Indian SGF & Vice President BS&G blessed the Gathering after paying tributes to Swami Vivekanand. Adrian Lamonte from Meghalaya State SGF gave a very interesting talk on 'Youth of today, India of tomorrow' 'Aaj ka yuva, kal ka bharat'. This was followed by speakers from among the youth members present. Inspiring talks were given by Payal Kalra, Alwar District SGF, Priyanka Prajapat, Ranger from Alwar, Om Bhuavaneshar of WR State SGF and Purva Madhukar Gaikwad of Lonavla Guild SGF. Everyone spoke very well about what youth expectations were, concerns and challenges of youth, role of parents in the all-round development of youth, etc.

This was followed by the much awaited talk by M.A.K.Mecci who spoke at length on the theme of survival and skills. His special emphasis was on SMART skills which was the need of the hour as the whole world has transitioned to relying on technology for day-to-day working and interactions. 21st century skills have now become absolutely necessary to adapt and get self-sufficient. He exhorted participants to relate to a tea-cup. 'CUP' – Concentrate, Understand and Practice, so that adapting to new situations turns out to be as easy as sipping a cup of tea/coffee!! He went on to give presentation on SMART – Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant and Time-based approach to achieve the goals we set for ourselves. He also dwelt

upon the effective use of Hands, Health, Head and Heart to give/work, live/be, manage/think, and relate/care. In conclusion, he said survival would be achieved by Critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, communication, information literacy, media literacy, technology literacy, flexibility, leadership, initiative, productivity and social skills. Each of these contributing factors was explained in simple but innovative way by M.A.K.Mecci which kept the audience spell-bound in attention.

All the Youth Speakers were recognized by Indian SGF NHQ & One Youth Award was announced for the year – K Kkashyap Award for 2021 was given to Aroop Sarkar, Deputy Director (Boy Program) of BS&G NHQ for his efforts to support and promote Scouting being professional. This program was followed by dinner.

The Grand Campfire was organized at 8.00 PM. All the teams entertained with their individual/group programs of song and dance and jokes and mimicry. There was event of fashion show, which was enjoyed by all. The participants walked the ramp in very sportive manner and was a success. With this colourful and festive atmosphere. The 2nd day was concluded with lots of enjoyment & lucky Draw. 3rd Day schedule & Site seen guideline was announced in the end.

Day 3: 09.01.2022

3rd day began at 7.30 AM with All Faiths Prayer. After a very solemn prayer session and breakfast, everyone gathered at 9.30 AM for the Closing Ceremony. Secretary General Seema Rathi thanked the participants and announced the venue of 16th National Gathering scheduled to be held at Yelagiri hills, Tamil Nādu & will be hosted by Tamil Nādu State SGF. She also observed that the gathering themes for the last couple of times have been in keeping with the gatherings themselves. 'change' for Varanasi which became the norm, because the gathering brought the change from physical to digital and we have been connected on zoom meetings after that. Now this gathering theme was 'survival' and we have all had to actually experience survival in the planning and accomplishment of this gathering. Wondering if we should give it a thought so that we keep an apt theme for the next gathering, she invited suggestions. Report of the 3 days gathering was presented in brief by Sujaya, scribe for the gathering. After this, all the Coordinating team members of Alwar were felicitated. Girish Gupta was recognized as 'Hero of the gathering'. He almost single-handedly managed and coordinated with all the activities. Girish Yadav who played the role of 'Suthraadar' throughout the gathering was also recognized and Rajasthan State SGF recognized for hosting, one flag was presented on which every participant written their thoughts about Scouting. Harish Chandra Kalra & Asha Kalra were honoured for overall coordination by NHQ. A scarf with all participant's signature was also presented as memorial of 15th National Gathering. Sampat Kothari gave congratulatory remarks and Madhu Kalia delivered Closing Remarks to the 15th National Gathering.

Winners of the fancy dress, Camp Fire, slogan writing and Fellowship Bazar were recognised and awarded. The results of competitions were: Fancy dress: Tarachand and Neeta (Raj), Fellowship Bazar: Meghalaya State SGF, Grand Campfire: Maharashtra State SGF, Slogan: Rashmi Sahu (UP). Alwar District SGF gifted special sweet to all National council members & working team and honoured Seema Rathi & Girish Gupta.

After an emotional conclusion of the gathering, all the members reported with packed luggage and checked out, for local sight-seeing. Groups of 8 each were taken for local sight-seeing in the arranged vaahinis, with packed lunch. The places included Company Garden, the heritage fort of Alwar, Hope Circus, Chhatri of Maharaja Bhaktavar Singh which was built in his memory by his son. It is the place where Moosi Rani gave up her life in Sati when her husband died. A visit to the museum was also arranged. The museum had on display various items used by the royal family, the Armory, weapons, cutlery, etc. All the groups returned to the venue for tea after sight-seeing and proceeded from there to their respective places.
