**Henfield Branch.** Many of our members are heavily involved with the charitable ( Clarkes Mead Trust) that is in the process of raising funds to rebuild the Henfield Scout Hut The old hut which was built many years ago by the B-P Guild has served fantastically well for all those years but it was definitely getting past it's best, and was becoming dangerous and unusable . The Scouts moved out in the summer of 2022 to temporary accommodation at another local site. This allowed us to start work on the site and the old scout hut was demolished late last year and construction of the new hut has started this year and the frame work is going up now 2nd week of February. This new building will be known as the Henfield Scout and Community Centre.



It has been designed in such a way that areas of the building can be hired out to different community groups or clubs when not in use by the Scouts thus aiding a large section of the community and raising funds to finance the buildings ongoing costs. # National Scout and Guide Fellowship UK

The National Scout and Guide Fellowship UK (NSGF UK) is the member organisation of the International Scout and Guide Fellowship (ISGF) for the UK. ISGF usually only recognise one organisation per country (there are exceptions in specific circumstances).

Therefore in the UK where there are 2 organisations, Baden-Powell Guild UK and the Scout and Guide Fellowship UK, they come together in a Joint National Committee (JNC) to form the National Scout and Guide Fellowship UK (NSGF UK).

The Joint National Committee is made up of 3 members from each of the 2 organisations. In the B-P Guild, the 3 members are nominated by the National Executive Committee and elected by the membership at the AGM every year. Once on the JNC members can serve for up to 6 years but must then take a break for at least one year.

With a couple of breaks I have represented the B-P Guild on the JNC since 2013. I am heading towards the point at the AGM in 2024 where I will once again have completed 6 years and must step down. This time as I am moving on to represent the Western Europe Sub Region on the Europe Region Committee. I will be taking more than a year's break.

**Therefore, from 2024, the B-P Guild will need to find a member to replace me on the JNC.** The other 2 members, are experienced & expected to be on the JNC for a number of years yet.

**What do you need to know to represent the B-P Guild on the JNC?** Very little. You will need to be a member and to know what the Guilds Purpose, Motto, Principles Aims and Objectives are, these are all detailed in the Constitution, you can get a copy from the National Secretary. Armed with this information the only other requirement is a willingness to be involved and possibly an interest in International affairs. The JNC only meet 'as required' and this is usually only 2/3 times per year, online via zoom and the meetings usually last no more than an hour. ## **ISGF 11th EUROPEAN CONFERENCE DENMARK**

### **30th July - 3rd August, Ranum Efterskole College**

Now is the time to Register for this European event, if you have not already done so. The Conference will take up only one day, Wed. 2nd August. The other days will be taken up by social events and excursions into the local countryside. **Information on the website, including details of the excursions and also the Post Conference 3 day tour of Denmark. If you would like to join this tour you need to register by 31<sup>st</sup> March.**

**There is a direct flight to Aalborg from Stanstead.** You will need to book for Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> July, with return on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> August (unless you are going on the Post Conference tour). The outgoing flight is AALFR1251 and it departs at 7.30am, you will need to be at the airport at least 2 hours before the flight time. The return flight from Aalborg to Stanstead is on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> August AALFR1250 and it departs at 17.35pm. There will be transport provided and included in the Conference price from the airport to Ranum and back to the airport. There are flights from other airports in the UK but for most of these you will have to fly to Amsterdam and then change planes for Aalborg.

If you book for the Post Conference tour it finishes in Copenhagen and you will need to book your return flight from there. **Do consider going to this event, you will make friends (for life) and learn more about what Guilds do in other countries.**
